



## Rev. A.C. Clemens

Ambrose Clifford Clemens, 99, of Selma, Indiana, peacefully left this world on Thursday, April 17, 2025. Having faithfully lived his life with the anticipation of living forever with Jesus, he is now home.

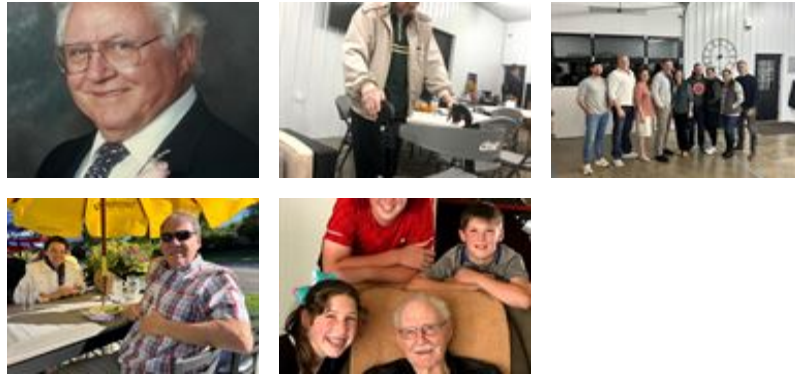
