October 31, 1917 - January 1, 2014

Aletta "Lucille" Keever Kelley, 96, of Farmland went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, January 1, 2014 at Parker Health Care and Rehabilitation Center.

She was born October 31, 1917 in Maxville, a daughter of the late Boyce and Iva (Kennett) Mills.

Lucille attended the Lincoln School in Maxville and on May 7, 1937 married the love of her life, Kienzle Keever, who owned and operated the Keever Dental Laboratory in Farmland.
