Allen Lee Kennedy, 65, of New Castle, passed away on the morning of Thursday, December 23, 2021, at Heritage House of New Castle.

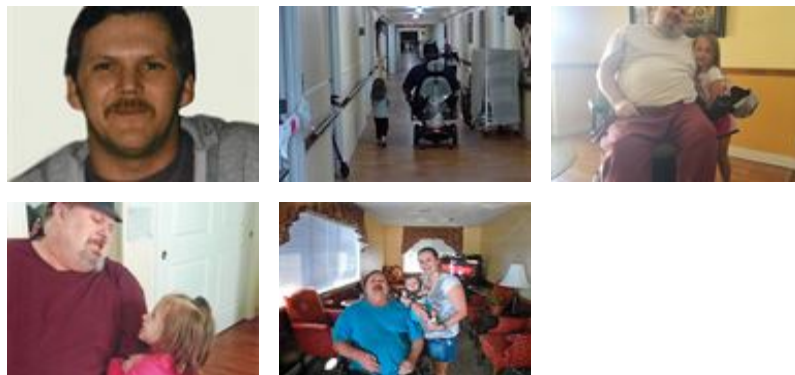
