



## Ann Smiley Stamps

August 24, 1944 - August 31, 2015

Ann (Smiley) Stamps, 71, of Viera, Florida, passed away peacefully on the morning of Monday, August 31, 2015 at Hospice Vitas in Viera, following a courageous five year battle with Alzheimer's.

She was born August 24, 1944 in Rushville, Indiana, a daughter of the late Gerald and Maxine (Walker) Smiley.

Ann was a 1962 graduate of New Castle Chrysler High School. Early in life she worked at Smiley Body Shop and then Western Electric in Indianapolis for several years. She enjoyed country music, dancing, playing cards and especially shopping with her daughter-in-law, Marlen. She was a long-time member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles (F.O.E.) and was active in the Women's Auxiliary.
