April 8, 1944 - January 9, 2018

Carolyn Sue (Gard) Cooper, 73, of New Castle, passed away on the evening of Tuesday, January 9, 2018 in her home surrounded by her loving family following a lengthy but courageous battle with cancer.

Carolyn was born April 8, 1944 in Mooreland, Indiana, a daughter of the late Kenneth Edgar “Shorty” and Frances Cathlene (Murray) Gard.

She graduated from Mooreland High School in 1962 and married the love of her life, Cecil Cooper, on August 22, 1965. Carolyn was a homemaker and loved spending time with her family. She was an avid bowler and was inducted into the Henry County Women’s Bowling Association Hall of Fame. Carolyn served as secretary of several bowling leagues for over 40 years.
