Carson E. Humes Jr., 54, of New Castle, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, August 1, 2025, at home.

He was born on May 15, 1971, in Muncie, Indiana, a son of Carson Eugene Humes, Sr., and Virginia Lee (Blake) Logan.

Carson was a 1989 graduate of Frankton High School and served in the U.S. Army. He worked in healthcare for 35 years, caring for the elderly and disabled. In recent years, Carson worked for Sevita and Rescare. He enjoyed fishing and wrestling, but his heart was in racing. Like his father and grandfather, Carson raced at Mt. Lawn Speedway, owning a couple of race teams and raced mostly street stock and front-wheel-drive cars.

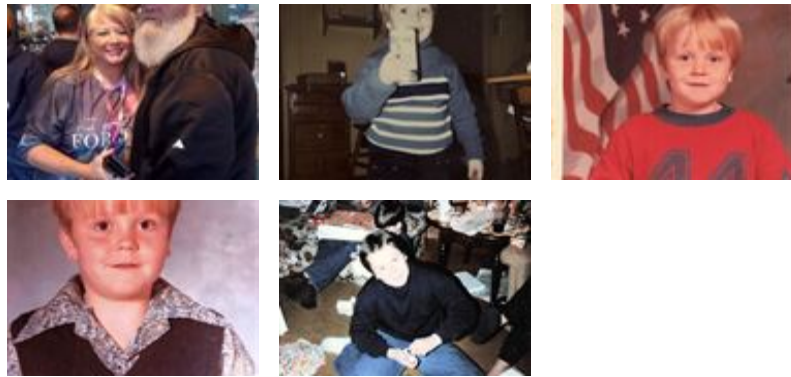
