Charles Eugene Huffman, 76, of Straughn, went home to be with the Lord on Christmas day following a lengthy illness.

He was born August 14, 1938 in Cambridge City, a son of the late Edward and Marie (Barnes) Huffman.

Charles served in the U.S. Navy. He worked for Ford Motor Co. in Indianapolis for 33 years retiring in 1997. Charles was an active member of the Greenfield First Church of the Nazarene serving on the board and the building committee for the new church. 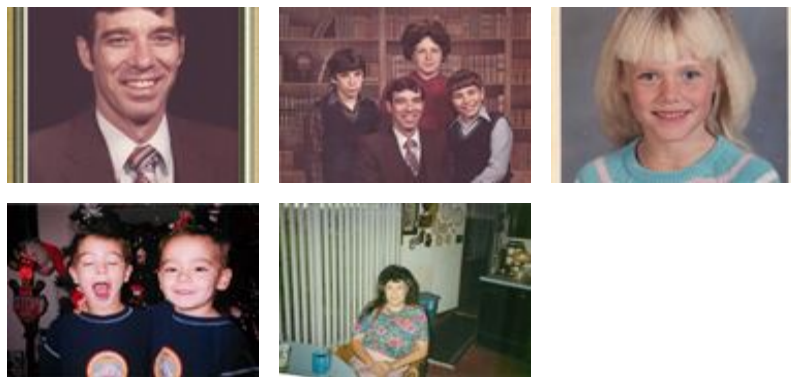

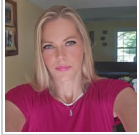

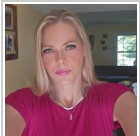
