Chuck Berry Jr., 40, of Oxford, Ohio, died Saturday, October 16, 2021, at Bethesda North Hospital in Cincinnati, Ohio, following a brief illness.

He was born on June 21, 1981 in Oxford, Ohio, a son of Kathy Ann (Hammonds) Berry and Chuck Berry Sr.

J.R. was a loving and caring soul with a heart of pure gold. He had an incredible sense of humor and was known and loved by many. J.R. was always on the go and loved playing guitar, being out in nature, fishing and hunting, and working on vehicles.

J.R. earned an Associate's Degree in Christian Counseling from International Christian College and Seminary. He had a heart for the incarcerated and ministered to men and women in jail. 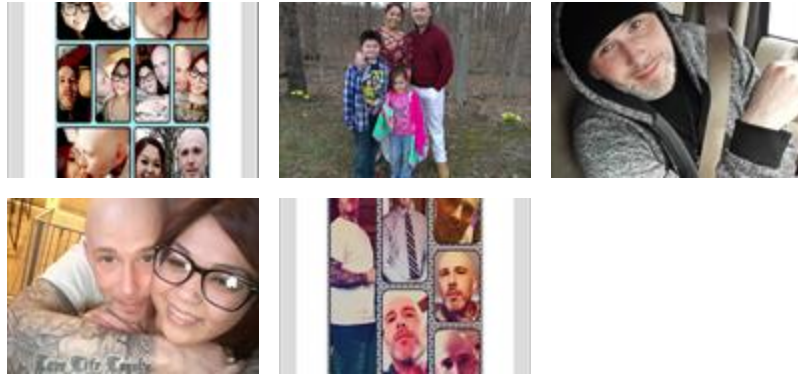
