Cindy Ann Meador, 67, of New Castle, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 5, 2025, at Ascension St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis, following a brief but courageous battle with cancer.

Born on November 9, 1957, in New Castle, Indiana, she was a cherished daughter of the late Joe Kenneth Ryan Lee and Diana Mae (Brewer) Lee.

Cindy was one of those rare souls who made every room brighter just by walking in. Vibrant, quick-witted, and full of life, she had a way of making everyone feel seen and loved. She was known for her outspokenness and a little bit of sass — traits that made her both a natural leader and a joy to be around. Beneath her bold personality was a heart of gold — deeply compassionate, loyal, and always ready to lend a hand or a listening ear.

traveling, discovering new places, and, most of all, spending time with her grandchildren — the lights of her life. Every holiday, every gathering, and every small moment with them was special to her.

A woman of strong faith, Cindy was a devoted member of Open Arms Church, where she found comfort and community.

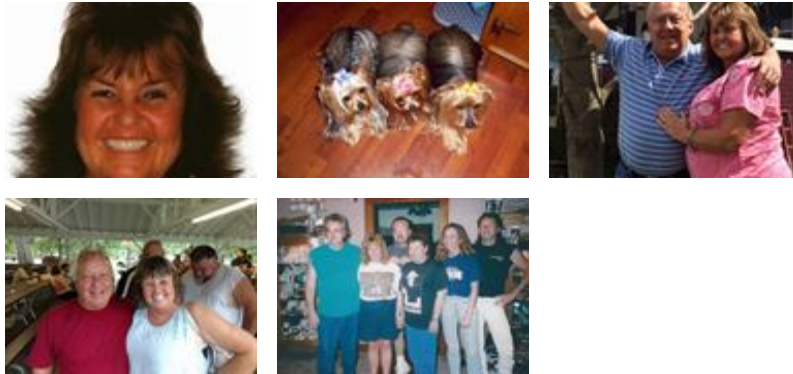
