He was a NASCAR fan and had the privilege of meeting his favorite driver, Jeff Gordon, at the start of the Brickyard 400 this year. Dakota was in the 6th grade at Northside Middle School in Muncie and loved his teachers, Ms. Greenwell and Mr. Craycraft. He was an outgoing young man and enjoyed attending the Muncie Pilgrim-Nazarene Church with Pastor Scott.


