Dale J. Yost, 88, of Springport, died Tuesday, January 8, 2012 at The Waters of New Castle.

He was born May 16, 1924 in Springport, a son of the late Dale H. and Hazel (Painter) Yost.

Dale was a 1942 graduate of Sulphur Springs High School and a 1949 graduate of Purdue University. He was employed at Richmond Baking Company retiring in 1989, he also worked at Gorton's Seafood in Cleveland, Ohio and farmed most of his life. He was instrumental in developing the breeding for the McDonalds Filet-O-Fish sandwich. Dale was a life-long member of the Springport Christian Church where he served as an Elder for over 30 years. He was also a former member of the Westlake Church of Christ while residing in Cleveland, Ohio. He played first base for the Henry County Softball Team in his younger years.
