Daniel R. Greene, of New Castle, passed away early Thursday morning, June 2, 2022, at The Waters of New Castle.

He was born April 30, 1947, in Richmond, Indiana, a son of the late Carl Columbus and Ida Isabella (Honaker) Greene.

Dan grew up in Cambridge City and graduated from Lincoln High School in 1965. He was a 1970 graduate of the Indiana School of Mortuary Science. In 1974, Dan became a part-owner of Fisher – Greene Mortuary in Cambridge City, and in 1978 he purchased the Faucett Funeral Home in Knightstown and operated it as Greene's Funeral Home for 32 years. Along with the funeral home, he owned and operated Greene's Ambulance Service. Dan enjoyed the outdoors, boating and fishing, and vacationing in Florida.
