David Raye Cross, 77, of New Castle, passed away early Monday morning, April 7, 2025, at home following a brief illness.

He was born on March 3, 1948, in New Castle, Indiana, a son of the late Homer C. and Evelyn I. (Favorite) Cross.

David graduated from Blue River Valley High School in 1966, where he ran track and played baseball. David was very athletic and had a passion for playing softball. He played in the men's league at Osborn Park and in tournaments all over. David was a hard worker and worked 32 years at Dana Corporation before retiring. For many years, he detailed vehicles on the side. He loved oldies and gospel music, attending car shows and cruise-ins.

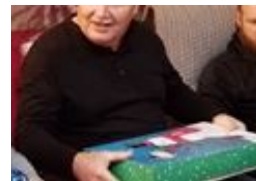
