February 1, 1945 - May 27, 2023

Rev. David Boyd Gardner, 78, of Frankfort, Indiana, went home to be with the Lord on the evening of Saturday, May 27, 2023 at St. Elizabeth Florence Hospital in Kentucky.

He was born on February 1, 1945 in Erie, Pennsylvania, a son of the late James Irvin and Helen Lucille (Boyd) Gardner.

Rev. Gardner married the love of his life, Rachel Anne Cope, on June 18, 1966 and together they served as missionaries to Haiti, The Dominican Republic, Mexico, & South Africa. He also volunteered with the Indiana National Guard as a chaplain at Camp Atterbury. Rev. Gardner began his ministry in the Free Methodist Church and also pastored for the Pilgrim Holiness, Wesleyan Holiness, ICHA, and the Church of God Holiness in Missouri. He loved cars - shopping for them, fixing them, and working for the Indiana Auto Auction transporting vehicles and interacting with his fellow employees. In his spare time, Rev. 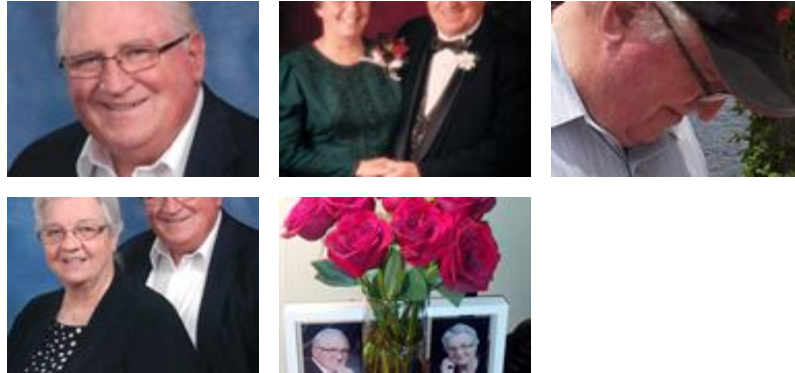
