David M. Smith, 49, of New Castle, died Tuesday at his residence following a long fight with cancer.

He was born May 14, 1958 in New Castle, the son of Dr. Mark and Janice Smith.

David was a 1976 graduate of New Castle Chrysler High School where he enjoyed running track and playing on the basketball team. He graduated from Taylor University where he majored in education and earned his Master's Degree in Educational Counseling from Ball State University. For the past 15 years he was a student counselor in Hagerstown, currently at the Junior Senior High School. He was a member of the New Testament Church of Christ in Hagerstown. He lived for his family and enjoyed fishing, woodworking and especially gardening.

He is survived by his loving wife, Jeanie Smith; three sons, Ben, Nate, and Caleb Smith all at home; four sisters, Cathy (husband: Bob) Osborne of Cincinnati, OH, Robin Abbott of Austin, TX, Laura Curtis of Charlottesville, VA, and Kim Sievers of Evansville; also several aunts, uncles, nieces and nephews.
