Delores Marie "Dee" (Webb) Anderson, 88, of New Castle, passed away on the morning of Thursday, August 17, 2023 at Henry Community Health.

She was born on February 24, 1935, a daughter of the late William and Leona (McQueen) Webb.

Dee liked to say she was "born a coal miner's daughter" in Briceville, Tennessee, and moved to Shelburn, Indiana as a small child. Following graduation from Shelburn High School, Dee moved to Detroit, Michigan, where she met and married William Ray Anderson, Jr. They moved to New Castle, where they raised five children. Dee enjoyed being a homemaker and also working at Meeks Florist, where she loved to arrange flowers. She went on to impact many children as a Librarian at Weir/Eastwood Elementary until retirement. Dee had a passion for nature, books, flowers, crafting, and especially her grandchildren. For over 60 years, Dee was a very active member of St. James Episcopal Church, and she was a life member of Sigma Phi Gamma Sorority and Daughters of the King.

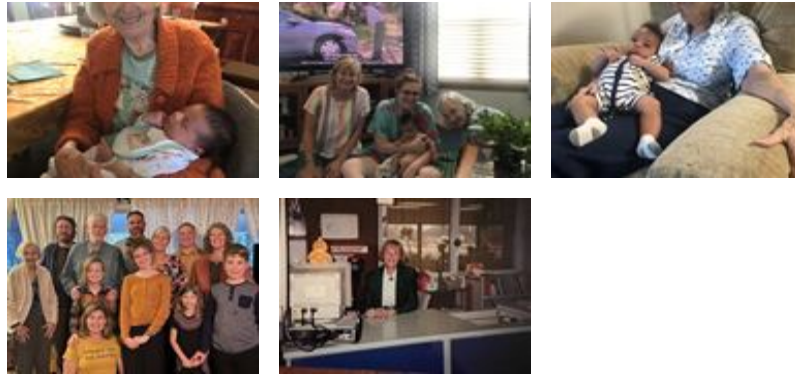
