



## Dillion "Max" Hilbert

August 27, 1936 - July 6, 2010

Dillion "Max" Hilbert, 73, of New Castle, died unexpectedly Tuesday, July 6, 2010 in Henry County Hospital.

He was born August 27, 1936 in Hagerstown, a son of the late Jessie Raymond Hilbert and Bessie E. (Gray) Hilbert.

Max was a 1954 graduate of Hagerstown High School and served in the U.S. Army. He briefly owned and operated Max's Restaurant in Milton then discovered a natural talent for sales. For many years he sold Kirby Sweepers, appliances for Montgomery Ward and life insurance. He enjoyed singing and recorded two country singles. He was a member of the Hagerstown American Legion Post #333.
