Don Russell, 78, of New Castle, passed away Tuesday, January 28, 2014 at Hickory Creek of New Castle following a lengthy illness.

He was born September 9, 1935 in York, Pennsylvania, a son of the late Allen and Gwendolyn Russell.

After graduating from high school and two years of seminary, Don found his expertise to be in sales and spent 25 years with the Rodefeld Company in Indianapolis.
