Dorothy E. Jones, 85, of Connersville, went home to be with the Lord on the morning of Wednesday, October 13, 2021 at Miller's Merry Manor in Chesterfield.

She was born on December 4, 1935 in Indianapolis, Indiana, a daughter of the late Urban Charles and Sarah Frances (Wilkerson) Berry.

Dorothy was a 1953 high school graduate of the Missionary Bands Training Institute in Indianapolis. She then attended the Frankfort Pilgrim Holiness College. Dorothy married the love of her life, Thomas Jones, on February 27, 1958, and together they enjoyed 57 years of marriage until his death in 2015. For many years, Dorothy worked in registration at Fayette Memorial Hospital in Connersville. Dorothy was often described as spunky with a great sense of humor.
