Ed Breneman, 86, of New Castle, went home to be with the Lord early Friday morning at Springhurst Health Campus in Greenfield following a brief illness. He was born June 4, 1922 in Henry County, Indiana, a son of the late Howard D. and Lura (Hoover) Breneman.
