



Dr. Eddie J. Guitart

January 30, 1920 - July 2, 2008

Dr. Eddie J. Guitart, 88, of New Castle, died Wednesday, July 2, 2008 in the Pinehurst Village in Centerville, Indiana.

Dr. Guitart was born January 30, 1920 in Cardenas, Cuba, a daughter of the late Dr. Raul and Josefa (Cru ll) Guitart.

She earned her Doctorate in Philosophy and Letters from Havana University in Cuba. She was a Professor of Literature at Sagua La Grande in Cuba and came to the United States in 1958. She worked 10 years at the Presbyterian Church Headquarters in New York. She worked many years in the Economic Research Department at Northwestern University in Illinois where she retired. She was an accomplished pianist and moved to New Castle from Chicago in March of 2000 to be near her sister. While in New Castle she attended the Grace Baptist Church.

She is survived by a sister, Agnes (husband: Herland) Tabares of New Castle; two nieces, Maria Tabares of Greenwood and Lilliana MendezSoto of Sacramento, CA.

She was preceded in death by her parents and a sister, Lillian Mendez-Soto. The funeral service will be held at 10:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 7, 2008 at Sproles Family Funeral Home with the Revs Denny Neal and Stan White officiating. Burial will follow in South Mound Cemetery West Lawn Addition.
