



## Edwin E. Pierce

October 10, 1917 - August 20, 2008

Edwin E. Pierce, 90, of Spiceland, went home to be with the Lord Wednesday at the Henry County Hospital.

He was born October 10, 1917 in Wayne County, Kentucky, a son of the late Floyd and Nora (Lowe) Pierce.

He was a long-time member of the New Castle Pilgrim Holiness Church where he served as an assistant Sunday School Teacher for the Adult Class and was instrumental in the construction of the church on Riley Road. He served in the U.S. Army as a Medic during WWII and retired in 1983 from General Motors in Indianapolis after 30 plus years of service. He loved to hunt and fish but most of all he loved to read his bible, attend church, and share Christ with others.
