Gale Stephen Geise, 79, of New Castle went home to be with the Lord following an extended illness on Monday, December 28, 2009 at his home. Gale was born February 13, 1930 in Union County, Indiana, a son of the late Claude and Kathryn (Fields) Geise.

Gale was a 1948 graduate of Connersville High School. He worked several years for Dresser Industries in Connersville then moved to Graham, North Carolina.
