Gary L. Boyles, 72, of Anderson, passed away on Sunday afternoon, August 4, 2024, at home following a lengthy illness.

He was born on November 30, 1951, in Little Rock, Arkansas, a son of the late Lloyd Franklin and Viva Lee (Roberts) Boyles.

Gary spent his early years in Little Rock, AR, Washington, DC, and Silver Springs, MD, where he graduated from Wheaton High School. Following graduation, Gary was drafted into the US Army to serve in Vietnam. Gary served courageously as a sharpshooter in the US Army Military Police. For his meritorious service in a combat zone, Gary was awarded a Bronze Star in addition to other medals of honor.

Following Gary's service in the military, he worked as a machine operator and welder. He also worked at Devlin Lumber Company in Maryland for several years. He moved to Indianapolis in 1993 and worked at a recycling center on West Street in Indianapolis before retiring to Anderson. Gary enjoyed watching football and was a lifelong Washington Redskins fan.

Those left to cherish Gary's memory include a brother, Lloyd Boyles, Jr. of Anderson; a sister, Ann (husband: Austin) Caudill of Indianapolis; two nieces, Dawn Bishop of Indianapolis and Stacey Terry of Frederick, MD; a great-niece
