Gary L. Elenburg passed from this world to the next on March 1, 2024 at the age of 73. He leaves with the love of his family and his faith in Jesus Christ.

Gary was born in Haleyville, Alabama, to William “Bill” and Ruth Elenburg on December 3, 1950. He attended Wapahani High School but graduated from Muncie Southside High School in 1968. He was a hard-working and conscientious rural mail carrier for the United States Postal Service for 36 years, retiring in 2014. He was a member of the Randolph-Delaware County Rural Mail Carriers Association.

He was a member of Fellowship Baptist Church where he served as a deacon and Adult Sunday school teacher for over 30 years. Gary enjoyed baseball and was a fan of high school and college basketball. He loved The Andy Griffith Show, the Statler Brothers, and a good meal.

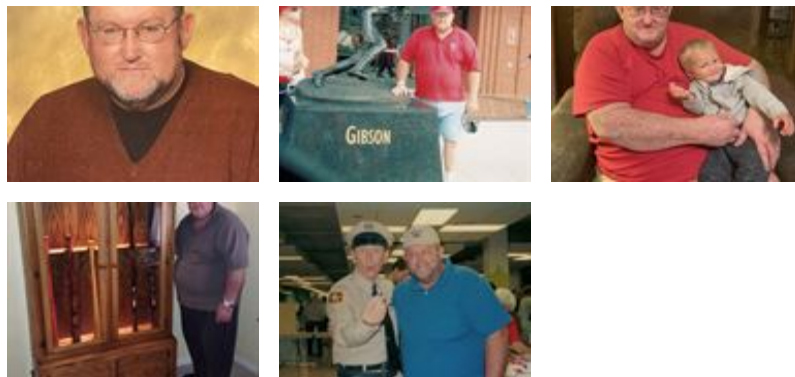
