Gary will be laid to rest beside his wife at Fairland Cemetery.

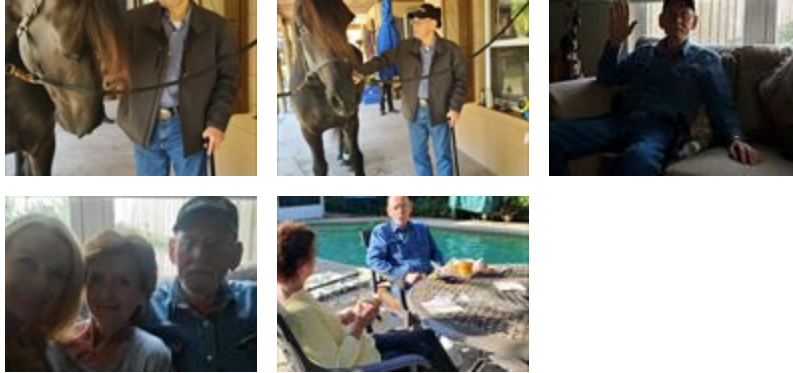
