Georgetta M. "Gid" Cooper, 76, of Greenfield, Indiana, went home to be with the Lord on the afternoon of Sunday, January 3, 2021 at IU Health North in Carmel.

Georgetta was a 1962 graduate of Prairie High School in Tipton County, Indiana, and attended Union Bible Seminary in Westfield. 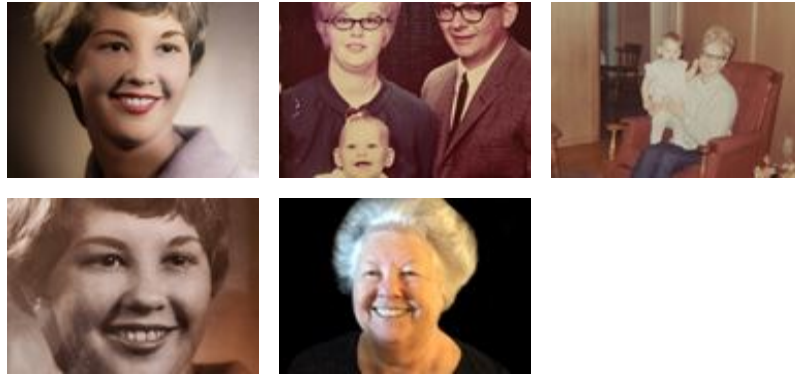
