



Goodson G. Marlow

April 2, 1909 - August 15, 2007

Goodson G. Marlow, 98, of New Castle went home to be with the Lord early Wednesday morning in Glen Oaks Health Campus following a brief illness. Goodson was born April 2, 1909 in Clinton County, Kentucky, a son of the late William Frank and Viva Anna (Catron) Marlow.

He was a member of the Pilgrim Holiness Church where he served as Sunday School Superintendent, teacher, treasurer, board member and trustee. He had been employed at the Hoosier Cabinet Company in New Castle and Chrysler Corporation for 39 years and 11 months retiring April 30, 1971. He was a veteran of World War II serving in the Army OSS, stationed in London, England.

He is survived by his wife, Ora May (Luttrell) Marlow, whom he married September 1, 1929 in the Pilgrim Holiness Church in New Castle; a daughter, Judith Noelene (husband: Steve) Haynes of Wabash, Indiana; a granddaughter, Melissa Ann (husband: Robert) Kinnett of Roann; a grandson, Craig Steven (wife: Shirley) Haynes II of Wabash, Indiana; three great-granddaughters, Sarah and Hannah Kinnett and Rebecca Haynes; two great-grandsons, Robert Kinnett III and Dayton Haynes; a brother, Windel Marlow of New Castle; several nieces, nephews and cousins including a very special nephew, Melvin Marlow.

He was preceded in death by his parents; four sisters, Mae Scott, Gladys Hill, Dorothy Davis and Marie Smith; and one infant brother, William Marlow.
