Harold Wolfe, 94, of New Castle went home to be with the Lord Friday, March 14, 2008 in Liberty Village of Muncie following a brief illness. He was born December 23, 1913 in Wren, Ohio, a son of the late Robert D. and Nora (Myers) Wolfe.

He was raised in Decatur, Indiana and worked in his family's poultry business and drove a truck for several years. He moved to New Castle and retired from Marhoefer Meat Packing Co. in Muncie following 28 years of employment. He loved horses and raised Tennessee Walkers. He enjoyed showing his horses and riding in the Mooreland Parades. He attended the New Castle Pilgrim Holiness Church where he dedicated his life to Christ at age 87. He was an inspiration and special blessing to everyone.
