Hollan H. Brewster, 82, of New Castle, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, September 20, 2009 in his home following a courageous battle with cancer.

He was born April 3, 1927 in Monticello, Kentucky, a son of the late Charlie and Mamie (Slaven) Brewster.

Hollan was employed by Irving Materials Inc. delivering concrete for 33 years. He was a hard worker and owned and operated his own business, Brewster Concrete Finishing, for many years. He attended Grace Holiness Church in Anderson and lived a life dedicated to Christ. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was an avid hunter and outdoorsman.
