Irvin "Slick" Wilson, 84, of New Castle, passed away at his home on the evening of Tuesday, June 2, 2026.

He was born on November 27, 1941, in Indianapolis, Indiana, the son of the late Irvin L. and Dorothy (Donaldson) Wilson.

A proud veteran of the United States Marine Corps, Slick honorably served his country before returning home to build a life centered around family, hard work, and the things he loved most.
