Janet (Neal) Sadler, 72, of New Castle, died Monday, April 6, 2009 in The Waters of New Castle.

She was born June 19, 1936 in New Castle, a daughter of Hoy O. and Nina (Teel) Neal.

Janet was a 1954 graduate of New Castle High School and earned a bachelor's degree from The University of Cincinnati in 1959. She also earned a master's degree in education from Ball State University in 1988. For many years she taught Adult Education for New Castle Community Schools.
