July 7, 1972 - October 31, 2023

Jason G. Firle, 51, of New Castle, died on the afternoon of Tuesday, October 31, 2023 at the Roudebush VA Medical Center in Indianapolis.

He was born on July 7, 1972, in New Castle, Indiana, the son of Charles “David” Firle and the late Linda (Richardson) Pickering.

Jason graduated from New Castle Chrysler High School in 1990 and, later that fall, joined the US Air Force. He met the love of his life, Tatina Curtis, in State Line, Idaho, and they married on January 11, 1997. Jason served in the US Air Force for nine years and was first stationed at Wright Patterson Air Force Base. He served two tours in Saudi Arabia, spent 15 months in Guam, and was stationed later at Fairchild AFB in Spokane, WA. While in the Air Force, Jason played softball for Team Air Force and traveled widely, playing teams in Japan, Korea, and the Western US.

Jason moved back to New Castle with his family in 2008. He enjoyed coaching teams in Little League and Babe Ruth Baseball, Upwards Basketball, Youth Football, and Salvation Army Basketball.

Since childhood, Jason has attended Foursquare Church. He enjoyed playing Bingo, Fantasy Football, The Chicago Cubs, and Chicago Bears.

Those left to cherish Jason's memory include his wife of 27 years, Tatina Firlle; his children, Christian (wife: Sierra) Firlle of Ft. Wayne, Grant Firlle, Brady Firlle (girlfriend: Sara), and Faith Firlle all of New Castle; his father, David Firlle of Lakeland, FL; a brother Aaron Firlle of Texas; a niece, Jordan Firlle; a nephew, Zane Firlle and many cousins and local relatives.

He was preceded in death by his mom, Linda Pickering, and by grandparents, James "JB" and Reatha Richardson and Charles and Viola Firlle.

Funeral services will be held at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, November 7, 2023, at Foursquare Church, with Pastor Jim Becker officiating. Friends may call from 3 – 6 pm Tuesday at the church.

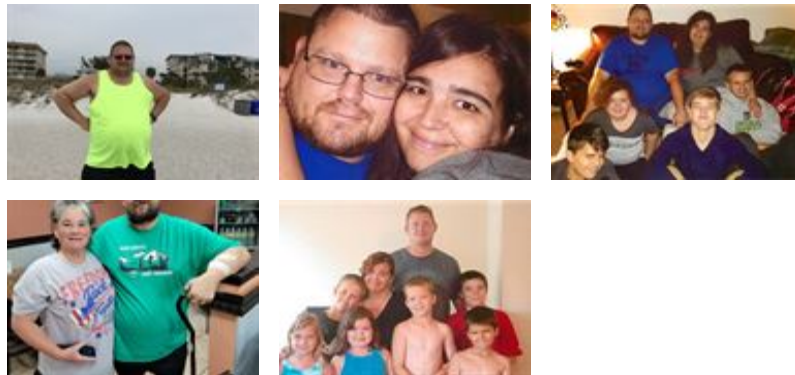
