Jeannetta F. Baker, 80, of Greensburg, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis.

She was born on May 9, 1943, in Greensburg, Indiana, a daughter of the late Howard Wesley and Ruth Amanda Isabel (Robbins) Fletcher.

Jeannetta graduated from Clarksburg Bible Covenant Christian School in 1961. She married Willard M. Baker on September 17, 1966, and together they enjoyed 54 years of marriage until his death in 2020. Jeannetta and her husband were foster parents to 134 children. She loved to sew, read her Bible, and play scrabble. Jeannetta cooked and cleaned homes and also served as a Home Health Aide. She was a devoted Christian, a dedicated pastor's wife, and a long-time member of Clarksburg Covenant Church. Jeannetta was a loving wife, mom, and grandma.
