



## Jessie W. Flowers

November 28, 1922 - May 11, 2010

Jessie W. Flowers, 87, of New Castle, died Tuesday, May 11, 2010 at Heritage House of New Castle.

Jessie was born November 28, 1922, in Hegira, Kentucky, the son of the late Johnny and Vinnie (Garner) Flowers.

Jessie was drafted at the age of 21, during WWII. He was a selected volunteer for the U.S. Navy and served on the U.S.S. Lynx AK100 from February 1944 to January 1946. He moved from Burkesville, Kentucky to New Castle in 1948. He married Margie (Nation) Flowers on May 28, 1948 in Glasgow, Kentucky with Rev. McCorkle officiating the ceremony. He retired from Chrysler Corporation in March, 1979, after 30 years and 10 months of service. He was a member of the New Harvest Church and was an avid fisherman and gardener.
