Juanita Wilson, 84, of New Castle, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, February 5, 2013 at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis following a brief illness.

She was born April 8, 1928 in Keno, Kentucky, a daughter of the late Gilbert and Girtie (Taylor) Wilson.

For many years, Juanita owned and operated Uptown Cleaners on 18th and G Avenue. In the 1950's she sang and played bluegrass with her first husband, "Little Jimmie Hughes" and the Country Boys Band. She often performed at Baker Park and sang live on WCTW where her husband worked as a DJ. She was a member of Mount Union Baptist Church in Keno, KY. She is survived by her husband of 53 years, Harold L.
