Kathryan Marie “Kathy” Schenck, 56, of Lemon Grove, California, died unexpectedly Friday, December 13, 2013 at Sharp Grossmont Hospital in La Mesa, Ca.

She was born April 2, 1957 in Indianapolis, the daughter of Rev. T. Eugene Schenck, Sr. and the late Thelma F. (Clark) Schenck.
