Kenneth W. "Kenny" Thomas Sr., 51, of rural Noblesville, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, May 18, 2014 at home following a brief but courageous battle with cancer. He was born April 12, 1963 in Terre Haute, a son of Sam and Linda (Farrand) Thomas. Kenny graduated from Terre Haute Baptist School in 1981. He married the love of his life, Sheila Preston, April 2, 1988. He was a truck driver since 1990, both local and over the road and was a dedicated Volunteer Firefighter with White River Township in Hamilton County. Kenny loved spending time with his boys, four wheeling, fishing, hunting, and with 4-H events. He attended Faith Holiness Chapel in Anderson for many years.
