Kenneth “Carl” Milbrodt, 74, of Indianapolis, went home to be with the Lord on the evening of Thursday, May 2, 2024 at Franciscan Hospice House.

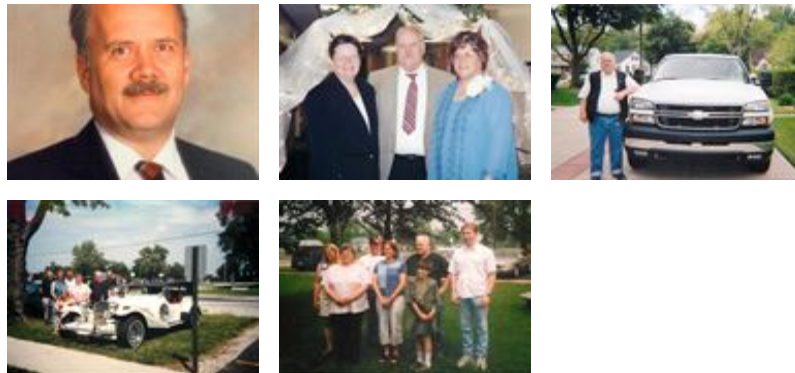
