Larry Lephart, 76, of Springport, Indiana, passed away on the afternoon of Friday, June 13, 2025, at Henry Community Health following an extended illness.

He was born on October 8, 1948, in New Castle, Indiana, a son of the late Harold and Priscilla (Lewis) Lephart.

Larry was a graduate of Blue River High School in the class of 1966. He served in the US Navy, and following his discharge in 1972, he began work at Ingersoll Rand Steel in New Castle. Being deeply patriotic, Larry re-entered the US Navy in 1987, serving for nearly six additional years.

He married Sheila Maureen (Kelly) on November 8, 1995, and they enjoyed shopping, dancing, and simply being together at home.
