January 7, 1948 - March 31, 2011

Larry L. McCune, 63, of Alexandria, went home to be with the Lord early Thursday morning, March 31, 2011, at St. Joseph Hospital in Kokomo following a lengthy illness.

He was born January 7, 1948 in Anderson, the first of seven children born to the late Ollie and Wilma (Hague) McCune.

Larry attended Grace Holiness Church in Anderson and greatly enjoyed volunteering with Anderson Christian Academy and coaching the boy's basketball team. He worked for many years at Ekrich Meats in Anderson and Peru and McClure Oil Corp. He was a Purdue University and New York Yankee fan.
