Laura F. Greenwell, 62 of Leesburg, Florida, formerly of New Castle, died Sunday, July 29, 2007 in Hospice of Lake & Sumter, Tavares, Florida. She was born March 6, 1945 in Cincinnati, Ohio a daughter of the late Joseph and Mary Adams.
