Linda Tyner, 80, of New Castle, bravely fought cancer for six years before a peaceful passing on the morning of Sunday, December 6, 2020 at her residence surrounded by her family.

She was born on August 17, 1940 in New Castle, IN, a daughter of the late Wyatt and Ina (Carnes) Jeffries.

Linda attended New Castle schools and later earned her Realtor License from Ball State University. She met the love of her life, John Paul Tyner, in 1956 and they were married a year later in 1957. They enjoyed 49 years together before John's passing in 2006. Linda was a realtor for many years in New Castle and worked under Properties Unlimited. Linda served as President of the Henry County Realtor Board, represented the board in Washington and also was awarded realtor of the year. She was a longtime member of the Tabernacle of Praise Church in Muncie where she loved working in the children and youth ministries. Linda also was an avid Walt Disney fan and shared that love with her children and grandchildren.

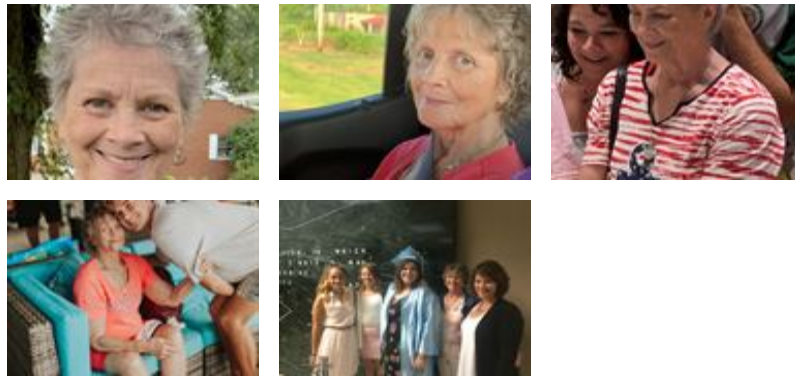
