Amazing “mommy” to Sydney and devoted wife and best friend to Brad, Lisa D. Fellers passed away Wednesday, April 10, 2024 after a brave two year battle with cancer. A little over a year and a half before her homegoing, Lisa, sitting in her favorite spot at home talking with Brad and a good friend, in her own quiet way, asked Jesus Christ to be her Lord and Savior. Best decision ever, period, according to her girl Syd.

Lisa was born 56 years ago on October 3, 1967 in Muncie, Indiana. She attended Muncie Central High School, graduating in 1986. A loyal 26 year employee of the City of Muncie’s engineering department, Lisa worked in a variety of roles during her career including bravely driving a street sweeper to help keep Muncie clean and operating a vac-con truck which is pretty impressive considering Lisa’s petite size.

Lisa was a gifted writer, journaling countless hours to ensure her daughter has a priceless legacy from her mommy. She was her daughter’s biggest sports fan and encouraged the love of art by painting with Sydney and doing other “artsy-fartsy” fun stuff. Lisa loved making people laugh with her great sense of humor, and loved going all out for the holidays even more, decorating their home and even their favorite campsite at Summit Lake. Camping, vacations to Florida and spending long quiet evenings with her family sitting on the front porch of their home listening to her beloved birds sing, were some of Lisa’s

favorite things to do. And snuggling with her much loved pug, Olive, was icing on Lisa's cake of life.

Throughout her battle, Lisa never complained about her cancer or the pain she was in. She was strong and courageous, more concerned about caring for her family and sharing her great sense of humor than worrying about herself. Her courage and love will be forever remembered by her husband of nearly 26 years, Brad Fellers, and her pride and joy, daughter Sydney Fellers. Lisa also leaves behind her mother and sister to cherish her memory.
