



## Loren Mitchell Jackson

April 2, 1926 - February 10, 2021

Loren Mitchell Jackson, 94, of New Castle passed away peacefully on the morning of Wednesday, February 10, 2021 at Harrison Terrace in Indianapolis.

He was born on April 2, 1926 in Wilkinson, Indiana, a son of the late Arthur Loren and Amy (Albea) Jackson.

Loren joined the United States Army at the young age of 18 and served from 1944 to 1946 during WWII. He was employed by Delco Remy in Anderson and retired after 30 years. Loren was a current member of the New Castle Assembly of God Church.
