Luke Bradley Miller, 21, of Richmond died July 14, 2007, unexpectedly in his sleep due to a medical condition.

He was born January 10, 1986 in Waxahachie, Texas the son of Mark W. and Vicky (Lowery) Miller.

He was a 2004 graduate of Hagerstown High School. He was a senior at IU East and attended Bethesda Worship Center in Richmond. Music was his passion in life, writing his first song at age 11.
