Mable Murdick, 88, of Indianapolis, went home to be with the Lord on the evening of Saturday, December 22, 2018 at the home of her son and daughter-in-law, Tim and Joyce, in Greenfield, surrounded by her loving family.

She was born November 9, 1930 in Bowling Green, Kentucky, a daughter of the late Joseph and Delia (Dearing) Hood.

Mable married the love of her life, Everett Murdick, a chiropractor and skilled carpenter, on September 5, 1951 and together they enjoyed 53 years of marriage until his death in 2005.

She worked at Fruit of the Loom in Bowling Green, Hallmark and Altenheim Nursing Homes in Indianapolis as a CNA, and Wesleyan Creative Childcare in Beech Grove. For many years she enjoyed babysitting her grandchildren. Mable was a Sunday School Teacher for seven years in the Junior Boys classes at Southside Nazarene and Eastside Nazarene where she volunteered for the food pantry. At University Heights Nazarene Church, Mable served as the Head of Visitation, Treasurer, and Pianist and in 1982 they bestowed on her the Distinguished Service Award. In recent years, she was a member of Independent Nazarene Church in Beech Grove.

Mable went back to school and earned her high school diploma at age 48. She loved to bake bread and did so for 67 years much to the enjoyment of her family. She enjoyed working the Daily Word Jumble, playing Scrabble, jigsaw puzzles, playing piano and accordion and reading.

Her faith was very important to her. Saved at the age of 11 at the Methodist Church in Kentucky, she was a faithful wife and mother who led her family through difficult times.

Mable said, "I didn't feel any different immediately after I got saved, but when I was halfway home I felt like I was walking on air and can still remember the place in the road where I felt that way." Mable had to walk 3 and a half miles from the church to her home.

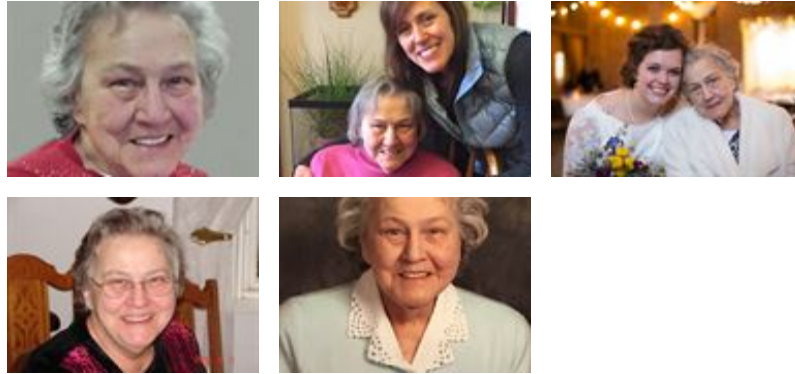
