Maggie E. Beckner, 81, of Mooreland, Indiana, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, June 22, 2025, at the Cleveland Clinic in Cleveland, Ohio.

She was born on September 2, 1943, in Albany, Kentucky, a daughter of the late Edgar Paul and Roxie Ellen (Ballenger) Stockton.

For most of her life, Maggie resided in Henry County and lived in Mooreland for the last 48 years. She attended New Castle High School and, on July 3, 1960, married the love of her life, Robert E. 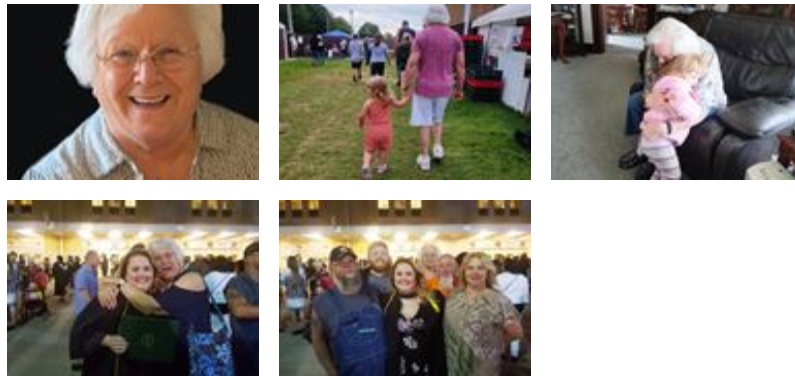
