Malcolm Irvin, 82, of Mooreland, passed away early Monday morning, February 26, 2024, at Glen Oaks Health Campus, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on September 20, 1941, at home in Mooreland, Indiana, a son of the late Luther and Vera Lee (Conway) Irvin.

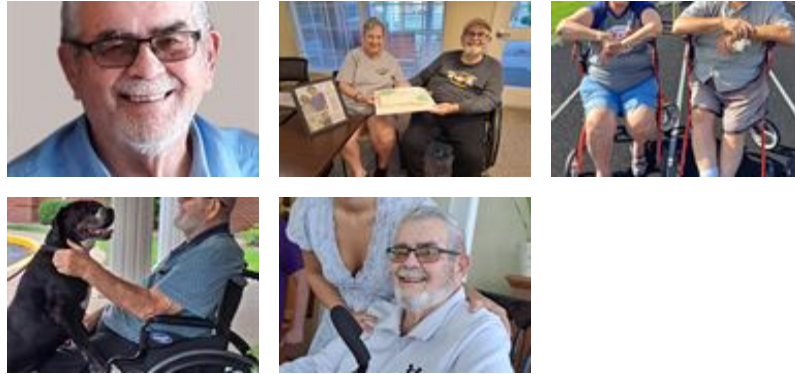
