Rest easy, precious Angel!

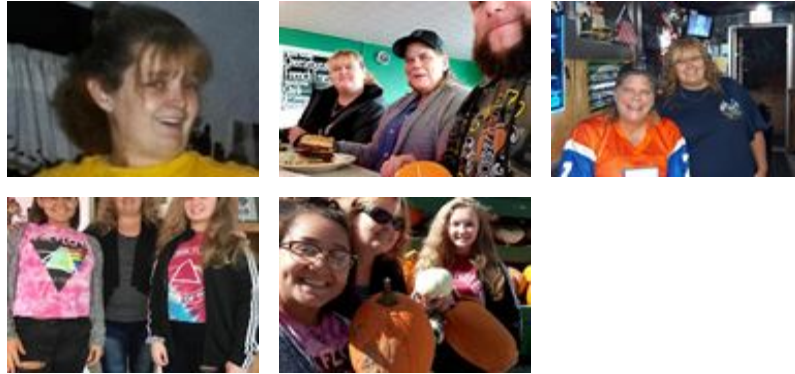

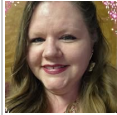
